You will be notified if any days you selected on the previous page are unavailable when we process your contract. To reserve your days/weeks, you MUST include your credit card information or pay for all tuition and field trips in full at the time of enrollment. We cannot reserve your days without your Credit Card information or payment in full. You can pay weekly by cash or check. Checks can be made payable to "XL". Otherwise, we will run your credit card each Wednesday for the following week.

By enrolling in the XL Summer Camp and signing this form, you agree to comply with all policies set out below and all policies and procedures in the Parent Handbook.

# **Camp Enrollment Policies:**

- Enrollment Contracts must be received by April 20, 2023, to guarantee your selected camp dates. We will continue to take Enrollment Contracts until all camp days are full.
- All campers must be enrolled for a minimum of fifteen (15) days.
- To attend any days in the last two weeks of camp, campers must be enrolled for 10 days prior to the last two weeks. No
  exceptions.
- Daily rate for campers: \$61/1<sup>st</sup> child, \$58/2<sup>nd</sup> child, \$46/each additional child.
- Payment is due on Wednesday by 9:00 am for the following camp week. All payments received after 9:00 am on Wednesday will be applied to your next camp week.
- You are responsible for paying for all days selected on your Enrollment Contract. There are no refunds, cancellations, substitutions, make-up days, or credits for missed camp days. If your child is absent for any reason, including illness, you will not receive a refund or credit for that day. \*\*Please see Parent Handbook for policies about COVID-19.
- A \$30 fee will be charged to your account for any checks returned for any reason.
- A \$25 late fee will be charged to your account if payment is not received by 9:00 AM on Wednesday for the following week's camp tuition. This applies to declined credit card payments.
- The deadline to revise your schedule due to changes in your school calendar is April 20, 2023.
- Payment for all field trips and swim trips is due by April 20, 2023. We will automatically run your credit card on file on April 20, 2023, for unpaid field trips and swimming trips. After April 20, payment is due at the time of enrollment.
- Campers must be enrolled in camp for the day to attend a field or swim trip.
- There are no refunds, credits, substitutions, or cancellations of any field trips for any reason.
- Campers who are removed or suspended from camp for any reason will not be refunded for tuition for the camp week in
  which the incident occurred and will not be refunded for any field trips that have been paid in advance.
- Any photos/video footage taken while your child is at the camp may be used for promotional purposes in print media and/or internet promotion. No financial compensation is available should such a picture/video be used.

The XL Summer Camp wants all our campers to have a rewarding and memorable experience. For this to take place, there are a few rules campers are expected to follow. Please review the following rules and discipline measures with your child to ensure that he/she has a fun, positive, and most importantly, safe summer.

# Camp Rules:

- 1. Be kind and respectful to yourself, others, and camp property.
- 2. Listen and follow directions.
- 3. Keep hands, feet, all other body parts, and objects to yourself.
- 4. Be responsible for your personal belongings always (not PK and K campers)
- 5. Leave expensive toys/cell phones at home. We are not responsible for the loss or theft of these items.
- 6. If you have a problem, always tell a counselor or a director immediately.

## Camper Consequences:

- 1. Redirection of camper
- 2. Verbal warning or time-out
- 3. Speak with Camp Director and phone call home (Child will speak to parents at that time)
- 4. If a second phone call is necessary, the child may be suspended from camp.
- 5. Parents will be notified in writing of the date the child will be permitted to return to camp.
- 6. In the event of severe, consistent, or excessive failure to follow the rules, the camper will be suspended or removed from camp. Campers must be picked up within 1 hour of parent notification.
- 7. There are no refunds, credits, or substitutions for any days a child has been suspended from camp.
- 8. If the camper severely endangers the physical, mental, or emotional health of another individual, the camper will be expelled from the camp.
- 9. XL Summer Camp reserves the right to terminate a child's enrollment at our discretion.

## PARENT/GUARDIAN AGREEMENT:

I, the undersigned, have carefully read and gone over the above rules and consequences with my child. I agree with the above policy and understand that in the event my child is suspended or expelled from camp for failure to follow the rules, I will not receive a refund for any camp monies for that time.
